Dear Member,

This has reference to our earlier Circular / of even number dated December 31, 2021 informing extension of last date upto 31st January, 2022 for submission of Applications under various schemes i.e. MEIS, ROSCTL, ROSL and SEIS. Since, some of the issues which were preventing the exporters in filing applications at online module still remain unresolved, ISEPC had made request to DGFT for further extension of the last date for filing of MEIS / ROSCTL / ROSL / SEIS applications.

We are happy to inform you that DGFT has accepted our request and extended the last date of such scrip upto <u>28th February</u>, <u>2022</u> for submitting / filing the claim applications under all the above Schemes vide DGFT Notification No. 53/2015-2020 dated 01.02.2022 (copy annexed)

Subject: Extension of Last Date for Submitting applications for Scrip based FTP Schemes

S.O.(E): In exercise of the powers conferred by Section 5 of the Foreign Trade (Development and Regulation) Act, 1992 read with Para 1.02 of the Foreign Trade Policy, 2015-20, the Central Government hereby amends the para 3.13A of the FTP 2015-20 (as notified vide Notification no. 26 dated 16th September, 2021 and amended vide Notification No. 48 dated 31.12.2021) with immediate effect. The para 3.13A shall now read as below:

3.13A: Last Date of Submitting Applications for Scrip based Schemes

- a. In supersession of the existing laid down provisions in the Hand Book of Procedures, 2015-20 with regard to last date for submitting online applications for scrip based claims, the last date for submitting online applications stands revised to 28th February 2022 for the following schemes i.e.
- i.
- i. for MEIS (for exports made in the period (s) 01.07.2018 to 31.03.2019, 01.04.2019 to 31.03.2020 and 01.04.2020 to 31.12.2020),
- ii. for SEIS (for service exports rendered for FY 18-19 and FY 2019-20),
- iii. for 2 % additional ad hoc incentive (under para 3.25 of the FTP for exports made in the period 01.01.2020 to 31.03.2020 only)
- iv. for ROSCTL (for exports made from 07.03.2019 to 31.12.2020) and
- v. for ROSL (for exports made upto 06.03.2019 for which claims have not yet been disbursed under scrip mechanism).

After **28.02.2022**, no further applications would be allowed to be submitted and they would become time-barred. Late cut provisions shall also not be available for submitting claims at a later date.

b. In supersession of the laid down provisions on applicable late cut as in para 9.02 of the HBP, the new late cut for applications submitted upto **28.02.2022** as indicated above shall be:
